

COOKIE POLICY

This Cookie Policy explains how **OZ Maritime** (“we”, “us”, or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website(s) (the “**Website**”). It describes what cookies are, how we use them, and the choices available to you.

This policy is designed to comply with applicable international data protection regulations, including the **EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** and the **ePrivacy Directive**.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile phone) when you visit a website. They allow the website to recognize your device, remember your preferences, and improve overall functionality and user experience.

Cookies may be **session cookies** (deleted when you close your browser) or **persistent cookies** (stored for a defined period or until deleted).

2. Types of Cookies We Use

a) Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Website and cannot be disabled in our systems. They enable core functions such as security, network management, and access to secure areas (e.g. client portals).

Legal basis: Legitimate interest / contractual necessity.

b) Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember choices you make (such as language preferences or region) and provide enhanced, more personalized features.

Legal basis: Consent.

c) Analytical & Performance Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our Website by collecting information anonymously. This data allows us to measure and improve Website performance.

Examples include page visits, traffic sources, and navigation patterns.

Legal basis: Consent.

d) Marketing & Targeting Cookies

These cookies may be set through our Website by third-party services to deliver relevant content, analyze campaign effectiveness, or limit repeated content display.

We do **not** sell personal data obtained via cookies.

Legal basis: Consent.

3. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be placed by trusted third-party service providers (e.g. analytics, security, or embedded content providers). These third parties process data in accordance with their own privacy policies and applicable laws.

OZ Maritime does not control third-party cookies.

4. Cookie Management & User Choices

Upon your first visit, you are presented with a cookie consent banner allowing you to:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies
- Customize cookie preferences

You may also manage or delete cookies at any time through your browser settings. Please note that disabling certain cookies may impact Website functionality.

5. Data Protection & Privacy

Any personal data collected via cookies is processed in accordance with our **Privacy Policy** and applicable data protection laws.

Where required, data may be transferred outside the EU/EEA using appropriate safeguards, including standard contractual clauses.
