

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how **OZ Maritime** (“**OZ Maritime**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, or “**our**”) collects, uses, stores, and protects personal data obtained through our website(s), digital platforms, client portals, services, and communications (collectively, the “**Services**”).

We are committed to protecting personal data in accordance with applicable international data protection laws, including the **EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** and other relevant privacy regulations.

1. Scope of This Policy

This Policy applies to personal data collected from:

- Website visitors
- Clients, shipowners, ship managers, agents
- Suppliers and business partners
- Users of our Client Portal and digital reporting systems

It does not apply to data processed on behalf of clients where OZ Maritime acts solely as a **data processor** under a contractual agreement.

2. Personal Data We Collect

Depending on the nature of interaction, we may collect the following categories of personal data:

- **Identification data:** Name, surname, job title
- **Contact data:** Email address, phone number, company address
- **Business data:** Company name, vessel name, IMO number, flag, Class
- **Technical data:** IP address, browser type, device information, log data
- **Account data:** Client Portal login credentials, access logs
- **Communication data:** Emails, service requests, inquiries
- **Compliance data:** Information required for Class, Flag State, or audit purposes

We do **not** intentionally collect special category (sensitive) personal data unless required by law or explicitly provided.

3. Purposes of Processing

Personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- Providing marine safety, certification, and ship supply services
- Managing service requests, reports, certificates, and invoicing
- Operating the Client Portal and digital reporting systems
- Compliance with Class Society, Flag State, and legal obligations
- Communication with clients, suppliers, and authorities
- Improving website functionality and service quality
- Security, fraud prevention, and system integrity

4. Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal data based on one or more of the following legal grounds:

- **Contractual necessity** – performance of services or agreements
- **Legal obligation** – compliance with maritime, tax, or regulatory requirements
- **Legitimate interest** – business operations, service improvement, security
- **Consent** – where explicitly required (e.g. marketing communications, cookies)

5. Data Sharing & Disclosure

We may share personal data with:

- Classification Societies and Flag State Administrations
- Regulatory authorities when legally required
- IT, hosting, and cybersecurity service providers
- Logistics, survey, or technical partners involved in service delivery

All third parties are contractually bound to confidentiality and data protection obligations.

We **do not sell** personal data.

6. International Data Transfers

Due to our international operations, personal data may be transferred outside the EU/EEA.

Where applicable, such transfers are safeguarded by:

- Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)
- Adequacy decisions
- Equivalent legal protection mechanisms

7. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to:

- Fulfill contractual and operational purposes
- Meet legal, tax, and regulatory requirements
- Support audit and compliance obligations

Retention periods vary depending on data type and applicable regulations.

8. Data Security

We implement appropriate **technical and organizational security measures** to protect personal data, including:

- Secure servers and access controls
- Encrypted communication where applicable
- Restricted access on a need-to-know basis
- Continuous system monitoring

Despite all measures, no system can guarantee absolute security.

9. Data Subject Rights

Where applicable, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Request correction or update
- Request deletion (where legally permissible)
- Restrict or object to processing
- Data portability
- Withdraw consent at any time
